Minute regarding memo filed by submitter group seeking an extension of time

[1] The Panel has received a memorandum from submitter 2514, David Lawry¹ on behalf of the submitter group² seeking an extension of time to file a response to the joint application filed by CCC and CIAL seeking minor corrections to Chapter 6 and Chapter 14³.

[2] Having reviewed the memorandum the Panel does not consider that any matters raised provide a legitimate basis for granting an extension of time. As we have made clear before, this is a confined process to consider minor corrections to a decision in accordance with the Order in Council⁴.

[3] Notwithstanding, we grant one final extension until **4pm, Tuesday 26 September 2017**. We consider this is more than generous in the circumstances and ought to give the submitter group sufficient time to confer and provide their response.
