Mike Davidson Chairperson of the the Shirley/Papanui Community Board invited Brooklands residents affected by the SPFLRZ and Cera red zone voluntary offer , to a drop in session meeting in Brooklands Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015

The meeting was to enable discussion on issues of concern and time frames facing the residents of Brooklands who were subject to the CERA red zone voluntary offer

The Board offered the residents opportunity to ask questions of Council staff about infrastructure, land drainage matters, and provisions in the proposed replacement Christchurch District Plan - SPFLRZ and Hazard chapters

Council staff from departments of Natural Environment and Heritage, Land Drainage, Principal Advisor Planning ,Planning Transport as well as Councillors and Community Board members attend

This was the first opportunity in more than five years the Brooklands residents have had formal contact or approach from Council or Community Board and the opportunity to raise concerns and speak about the situation they are in and facing

The residents subsequently wanted to participate in the District Plan process affecting them, their futures and their properties, - to make statements/submissions on the provisions of the SPFLRZ

The residents want to contribute and feel involved in the process affecting their community of Brooklands

Could I ask the Hearing Panel to please allow the submissions to be presented in the format I have provided for the residents, and as statements in support of Submission 3232 Jan Burney, or to be presented in the manner in which the Hearing Panel would find most appropriate.
